DORES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TRUST POLICY ON BURSARIES FOR LOCAL STUDENTS

- 1. Applicants must have been resident in the parish for the previous twelve months.
- 2. There will be no age limit.
- 3. Applicants must be studying for a formal qualification such as HNC, HND or degree. They must include with their application a letter of acceptance for their course from the relevant establishment.
- 4. A fund of £1,500 pa will be set aside for this purpose. Further sums might be available, at the board's discretion, depending on other commitments.
- 5. The amount payable per annum per applicant will be £150 for non-residential courses and £300 for residential ones.
- 6. Applicants may apply more than once during their course, but only once in any one academic year; i.e. applicants on a three year course may apply a total of three times during the period of their course. Priority will be given to those applying for the first time.
- 7. The window for applications will be a 4 week period in September / October for the academic year then starting.
- 8. Applicants may be asked to report back either verbally or in written form to explain how the money helped support them. eg purchase of books, tools, travel costs and to share their course experiences possibly at local schools to help broaden younger peoples experiences.
- 9. The Board reserves the right to amend these guidelines yearly.

Sporting Bursaries

- 1. Applicants must have been resident in the parish for the previous twelve months.
- 2. There will be no age limit.
- 3. Applicants must be competing in recognised official sporting events at a national or international level.
- 4. A fund of £500 pa will be set aside for this purpose. Further sums might be available, at the board's discretion, depending on other commitments.
- 5. The amount payable per annum per applicant will be £100.
- 6. Funds will be allocated on a first come, first served basis, but priority will be given to those competing in an event for the first time.
- 7. Applications may be submitted at any time, but the funding year will run from 1 January to 31 December.
